**Synopsis** : This course covers five main parts of social psychology. Part one discusses theoretical perspectives in social psychology; perceiving people and events. Part two discusses attitudes and influence covering topics such as attitude formation and change; analysis of prejudice; and process of social influence (conformity and compliance). Part three examines social interaction and relationships. Part four focuses on helping and hurting others on topics such as pro-social behaviour and aggression. Part five discusses social psychology at work: application, management and implications in educational settings. Throughout this course, the results of empirical research – survey, experiments, observational and qualitative studies, and meta-analyses – will be used to illustrate the topics discussed.
