4 <sup>th</sup> Jan 2016 (Monday)	Supervisor of Research Study I submits mark (max=100%) of their students to the Faculty	<ul> <li>Faculty returns the evaluated Research Study II report to the students</li> <li>Students need to:         <ul> <li>a) discuss with supervisor on Examiner's 1 comments</li> <li>b) make correction(s) based on comments of the Examiner 1 if necessary</li> </ul> </li> <li>Faculty contacts students to reprint report of Research Study II report to be evaluated by another Examiner (for students who get marks of ≤ 12% from Examiner 1)</li> </ul>
<b>5<sup>th</sup> Jan 2016</b> (Tuesday)		<ul> <li>Students who get marks of ≤ 12% from Examiner 1 are required to resubmit Research Study II to the Faculty to be evaluated by Examiner 2</li> <li>Faculty distributes Research Study II report to Examiner 2 for evaluation</li> </ul>

		<ul> <li>Faculty returns the evaluated Research Study II report to the students</li> <li>If the student passes: The student needs to discuss with supervisor on examiner's comments and make correction(s) based on comments of the examiner</li> <li>If the student fails: the student need to reregister RSII in the following semester.</li> </ul>
<b>20<sup>th</sup> Jan 2016</b> (Wednesday)		<ul> <li>Students submit to the Faculty:</li> <li>2 copies (hard cover) of Research Study II report</li> <li>2 CDs that consist of Microsoft word and PDF files of the Research Study II report</li> <li>completed Research Study II report submission form</li> </ul>



## **Regulations and Guidelines**


- Percentage of assessment from supervisor and examiner
- RS I: 100% from supervisor
- RS II: 70% from supervisor & 30% from examiner – students can fail if marks from examiner is ≤ 12% from examiner.
- Thesis manual (thesis format guideline) –
   check SPS website / faculty website



- Attendance: regular meetings with supervisor is a must. Attendance is part of assessment.
- Submission of RSII report to the faculty must be within the dates assigned. Late submission will not be entertained.
