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

What is a theoretical framework?

- A theoretical framework consists of existing theory or model that is used for your study.
- The theoretical framework must demonstrate understanding of theories that are relevant to the topic of your research.






Why do we need a theoretical framework?

- To show the theories that support your research
- To show that your work (research) is grounded by established ideas.



Strategies to develop a theoretical framework?





Strategies to develop a theoretical framework

- 1. Examine the key concept of your research
 - Clearly define the key concept from problem statement and research question
- 2. Brainstorm about what you consider to be the key variables in your research
 - Answer the question, "What factors (IV) contribute to the presumed effect (DV)?"
- 3. Review related literature.
 - Find how scholars have addressed your research problem. Identify how previous research addressed the problem.



Strategies to develop a theoretical framework

4. List the constructs and variables

 List the constructs and variables that might be relevant to your study. Group these variables into independent and dependent categories.

5. Review key social science theories


- Evaluate, make comparison and selecting relevant theories that underpinning your study
- **6. Discuss the assumptions or propositions** of this theory and point out their relevance to your research.
 - Justify the selected theories that you had chosen



Make sure your theoretical framework provides a clear and logical structure for your research



What is a conceptual framework?


- A conceptual framework is a diagram depicting the relationship between various variables.
- A conceptual framework show relationships between different ideas and how they relate to each other.



Why do we need a conceptual framework?


- To show the relationship between the variables (IV and DV) involved in our study.
- It helps you visualize your research variables.




